




# A Heartfelt Farewell







Ms Williams will be leaving Holy Trinity today to continue and build upon the amazing work she has accomplished in Holy Trinity in another school.




We wish her well with God's abundant blessings, protection and love in her new career.



Dear Parents/Carers.

I am writing to advise you of the National Education Union's call to its members to take part in Industrial strike action following a ballot in regards to:

- The proposal to close Holy Trinity Church of England Primary School in Lambeth.
- Fallure of the employer to provide assurances there will be no compulsory redundancies arising from the closure.

The NEU's Interim Deputy General Secretary has stated that strike action will commence on Thursday 18th July 2024. I have been informed that our teaching staff will be taking industrial action to strike and having reviewed our options based on the impact of staffing upon pupil safety, Holy Trinity will be closed to all children on Thursday 18th July 2024. Breakfast Club and all after school clubs/activities will not be in operation.







