

'I think respect and being responsible is important.'


'Making decisions and involving each class.'

We look forward to the changes they plan to make this year.



They are based on the following consent-related criteria, violence, grown-up thereon, discrimination, fear, use of language, gambling and illegal activities.

#### Apps use

Consider frow you are using corresunication apps with friends. Try to readed habits that show your own awareress of the permunerace of ordine information. If preyene was to see the contents of your communication would this embarrass you in any way?

Many propular pames offer ordine player communicate capabilities and cracourage the purchase of add-ons to advance within the game. Demonstrate your own scepticism when it comes to in-app purchases.

#### Openness

#### Personal information

Only share information unline that you know wouldn't cause any harm if a person with bad intent, or even an employer, were to see it.

#### Security
