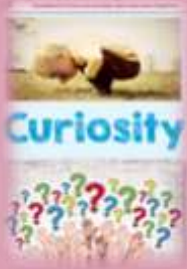

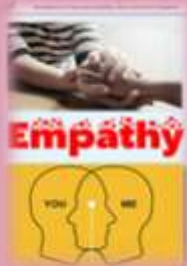


Our prayer for this week:
