Dear Parents/Carers,

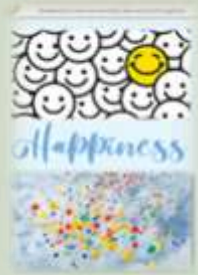
This week we reflected upon our school affirmation:
