

Father God we thank you so much for the wonderful children you have given us. You also reminded us that our children are Like arrows in the hands of a mighty warrior.




Lord we know that you have the destiny and path of our children firmly in your hands, and because of this our heats are at peace because we know that you will keep them safe.










Tips to Promote Positive Body Image
