Lord we know that you have the destiny and path of our children firmly in your hands, and because of this our hearts are at peace because we know that you will keep them safe.

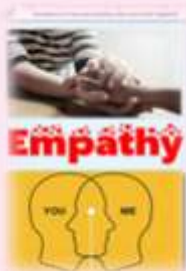
