









But he was wounded for our transgressions, he was bruised for our iniquities: the chastisement of our peace was upon him; and with his stripes we are healed.






Dear Parents and Care Givers,

RE: SPRING TERM COMMUNITY CLINICS

To ensure every child is protected, the school-age immunisation service is offering extra vaccination clinics at trusted local community centres. These clinics are for children who missed their in-school vaccinations and need to catch up on the following:

- DTP (3-in-1 teenage booster) protects against tetanus, diphtheria and polio
- MenACWY protects against Meningococcal groups A, C, W and Y.
- HPV protects against cancers and genital warts caused by specific human papillomavirus (HPV) types
- MMR protects against measles, mumps and rubella.
