






WORLD WIDE CONTRIBUTION TO VE DAY VICTORY IN 1945





We are thankful to God for the selfless service of all these great men and women, our prayers for their families and descendants is that the void left in there families will be filled with the love and peace of Christ







Deen City Farm and Riding School - **LOW COST**

Meet the animals, book a riding lesson or explore the gardens.

The 5-acre site is home to a host of animals, including donkeys, guinea pigs, turkeys, an alpaca called Kimby and two Shetlands cows called Meg and Brie.

Enjoy a leisurely stroll through the farm at your pace, drop in to a meet and greet session where you can pet the smaller residents, or book a larger animal encounter to get up close to a goat, sheep or donkey.

Other bookable activities include short pony rides for little ones aged from two years old to seven years old, longer rides for children aged four years old and above and riding lessons for children and adults.
