Next week we will be marking Mental Health week and focusing on how physical activities can support healthy mental well being.

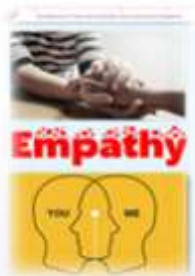

ONLINE SAFETY NEWSFLASH

The Online Safety Act: Are Children Safer Online

Internet Matters has produced a new report, using data from surveys and focus groups. It offers a view of how new online safety rules are shaping families lives.

The report contains good news, such as:

- Seven in 10 children and parents report seeing more safety features such as ways to report and filter content.
- Around half of children have been asked to verify their age on platforms.

54% of children report that the content they have seen online recently is more child-friendly.

However:

- Almost half of children think that age checks are easy to bypass (fake birthday, drawing on facial hair).
- A quarter of parents have allowed their child to bypass age checks.

Almost half of children say they have experienced harm online in the past month.

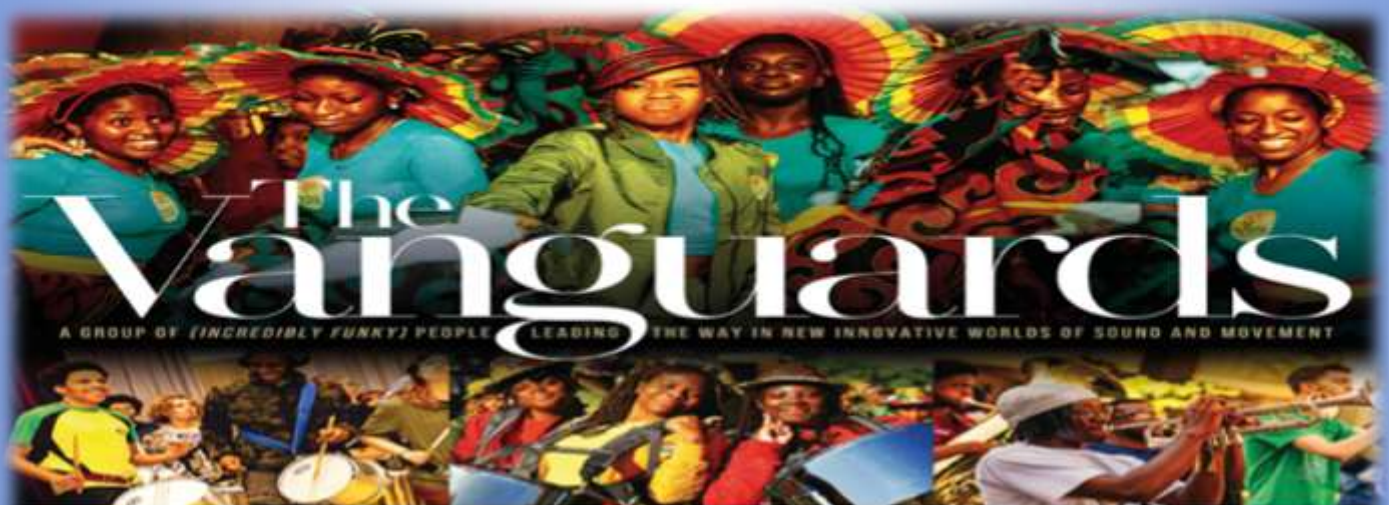
